Dear CLCC Owners:

This email is to communicate the latest information about the East Troublesome Creek fire and its impact on Columbine Lake Country Club.

As most of you already know, the fire blew up yesterday and high winds drove it eastwards very quickly to the Grand Lake area. A mandatory evacuation order for our area was issued yesterday at 18:57 by the Grand County Sheriff. As far as we know right now, everyone who was there in the community, including our staff, made it out safely.

At this point, nobody has been able to access our community or has definitive "official" news about properties in our community. From monitoring different Grand County websites and maps and listening to Grand County emergency services scanner audio, we do know that the fire did enter into CLCC at some point last night. What we have been able to learn is that some structures were impacted by the fire but other structures were spared. Sorry, but we just don't have any details yet.

What is clear though, is that the first responders and firefighters did a fantastic job in trying to save as much of our community as possible. Whatever the end result is, we owe them a huge debt of gratitude for their heroic efforts.

Listed below are links to some websites or audio feeds that will provide you with the most up-to-date information about the fire. The fire is still very active in the area and high winds are forecast once again so we are definitely not out of danger yet.

All roads into the area are closed to non-emergency traffic, so please do not attempt to travel to CLCC right now. To receive a notification from the county as to when you can safely return, you need to register at gcemergency.com. Follow the link to "East Troublesome Fire", scroll down to the Office of Emergency Management and click again for "East Troublesome Fire Information". Then scroll down again and click on "East Troublesome Fire Evacuees Registration Form". The registration form will ask which evacuation area your property is in. CLCC is in Evacuation Area S.
